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1. General comments

This mission report was prepared within the EU Twinning Project “Further Strengthening of the Georgian Statistical System”.

Purpose of the activity was to prepare for the implementation of Component 1. The focus was on the overview of statistical production in BC (Geostat) and analyzing the HR strategy and the role of Change Champions and presenting the best practices in MS (Statistics Finland). The mission fully achieved the results.

The consultants would like to express their thanks to all officials and individuals met for the kind support and valuable information which they received during the mission, and which greatly facilitated the consultants’ work.

The views and observations stated in the report are those of the consultants and do not necessarily reflect to the views of EU, Statistical Office of Georgia, Statistics Finland, Statistics Germany, or Statistics Italy.

2. Status at the beginning of the mission

This was the first mission of the Component 1 of the Twinning project. The aim of the mission was to form an overview of statistical production at Geostat, analyze the HR strategy and the role of Change Champions and to present the best practices in MS.

At the beginning of the mission, the Executive Director of the Geostat presented the administrative structure of the Geostat and the progress that Geostat has already achieved in developing its statistical capacity and aligning with international standards.

In discussion, the BC component leader talked about the recommendations received from the Eurostat/UNECE/EFTA joint team’s Global Assessment (GA) report, which includes a recommendation to implement process-oriented statistical production in Geostat. Geostat is now committed to modernizing its processes in accordance with the GA recommendations and the NSDS 2024-2027, by adopting the best practices from the EU. As part of this effort, Geostat requested a Sector Review of GSBPM implementation in February 2023 to identify areas for improvement and develop a roadmap for organizational change. The report from this review provides a strong foundation for Geostat's modernization efforts and will be further developed in future strategies.

The HR representative talked about the Georgian legislation concerning civil servants and public authorities’ responsibilities, including surveying staff satisfaction on a regular basis. In discussions also the difficulties to recruit staff and high turnover of staff in some subject areas were mentioned.

3. Status of mission results

The results stated in the ToR were fully met. During the mission following presentations were conducted:

- Presentations conducted by the BC:
 - o General overview and organizational structure of Statistics Georgia
 - o Implementation of the GSBPM in Geostat
- Presentations conducted by the MS:
 - o Enterprise Architecture and the GSBPM-based production model at Statistics Finland
 - o HR strategy in transition at Statistics Finland
 - o How to recognize the roles and capabilities required in the future
 - o Different roles in change at Statistics Finland

Based on the presentations and discussions it was possible to get a clear overview of current situation regarding statistical production at Geostat. The analysis of HR strategy and of the role of Change Champions was discussed and the way forward was agreed.

4. Sustainability of the achievements

All parties agreed on the next steps. Should the need arise, adjustments can be made later through the rolling work plan.

5. Recommendations for the future (short and long term)

The mission recommends clarifying and communicating the future target process model with the help of Enterprise Architecture to the staff of Geostat. This includes the production process, organizational change and the new roles required to ensure the production in the future. The description, e.g. process diagrams, of the current status at different levels could serve as a basis for determining the roadmap for the change.

6. Identification of needs for additional support

No need for additional support outside of this twinning project identified.

7. Outstanding issues and next steps

Tasks to be concluded before the next mission on the sub-component 1.1.:

1. Description of the current status of processes
2. Identifying what is working well, what is not (SWOT analysis) on the basis of Staff Satisfaction Survey.

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Next steps:

1. Setting the target state (upper level) of the process-based production model with the help of Enterprise Architecture.
2. Communicating the select priority (data collection) in the change towards process-based production model.
3. Describe the target state of the priority area using the GSBPM model.
4. Start the skills mapping work on the chosen priority area.
