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1. General comments

This mission report was prepared within the EU Twinning Project "Support to the State Statistical Committee and the State Tax Service under the Ministry of Economy to strengthen collection, harmonization, analysis, publishing and dissemination of business statistics". It was the second mission to be devoted to 'A business case for compliance of the statistical units in the SRSU developed' within Component 1, Result 2 within Activity 2.1 of the project.

The purposes of the mission:

 Identifying data sources, preliminary data acquisition and creating Enterprise Groups (EG) based on ownership data

The consultants would like to express their thanks to all officials and individuals met for the kind support and valuable information which they have received during the Remote Sessions and which highly facilitated the work of the consultant.

This views and observations stated in this report are those of the consultants and do not necessarily correspond to the views of EU, SSC, STS, SME-Agency, Statistics Finland, Statistics Lithuania, Statistics Netherlands, Statistics Denmark and HAUS.

2. Status at the beginning of the mission

Activity 2.1.B was carried out on four Remote Sessions (RS - WebEx meetings). Last RS presented the observations made during the previous sessions and translated into proposals for improvements, whereas the RS's before focused on analysing the situation in STS and SSC and presenting best practices out of MS.

- The mission was a direct continuation of activity 2.1.A.
- Information about the EU recommendations regarding enterprise groups, the enterprise group register and the statistical unit enterprise as well as MS experience in regard to those areas was delivered to BC during activity 2.1.A.
- Various possibilities for implementing the Enterprise group in the statistical business register in Azerbaijan have been considered.
- It was agreed at the end of activity 2.1.A that BC would start compiling the demo EGs and 'chains of control' with the existing subordination code.

3. Status of mission results

- An analysis of the administrative data with subordination showed that this data only had links for governmental units and therefore in its current form cannot be used as a point of departure for the creation of EGs
- Five large EGs have been selected for the manual creation of EGs based on public information available on web sites.
- It was decided that the possibility of obtaining administrative data regarding subordination or ownership from STS would be explored.
- A method to build an enterprise group register using direct links was demonstrated.
- The enterprise group register interfaces in the MS were demonstrated to exemplify what kind of information is stored and how the register can be used













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- A trial run of the creation of an enterprise group was carried out by the BC in excel using web site information and shared with the experts

4. Sustainability of the achievements

Through the presentations and the subsequent discussions, the BC has achieved a good understanding of the nature of the statistical unit "enterprise group" and of the methods to create an enterprise group register by using direct links. The BC has also started applying these methods for trial runs on a few very large enterprise groups. Getting access to relevant administrative data or other sources containing ownership links (e.g. financial reports) is, however crucial for the sustainability of the work.

5. Recommendations for the future (short and long term)

- Solve the data confidentiality issue as referred to in the previous mission report
- Explore other alternatives to get data on links between legal units
- Outline way forward to implement changes in the BR structure and needed software changes for EGR
- Start building chains of control as an exercise aiming the set-up of the enterprise group register in BC
- BC should only proceed with implementation of the statistical unit enterprise after the establishment of the enterprise group register

6. Identification of needs for additional support

BC should be able to proceed the work with enterprise groups. This project will continue working with this result also in the near future.

7. Outstanding issues

There are no specific outstanding issues.
