Renovations of non-residential buildings

EUR 1.6 billion were used for renovating commercial and office buildings

According to Statistics Finland, EUR 980 million were spent on renovating office buildings and EUR 620 million on renovating commercial buildings in 2020. Compared with the previous year, the renovation costs of commercial buildings decreased by 12 per cent and those of office buildings by 22 per cent. In total, the renovations of commercial and office buildings decreased by 19 per cent.

In 2020, industrial and warehouse buildings were renovated for EUR 1.3 billion and service buildings for EUR 1.6 million. The renovation costs of industrial and warehouse buildings decreased by 9.6 per cent and those of service buildings by 10.7 per cent from 2019.

The value of commercial and office building renovations was last studied with a sample survey concerning the renovations in 2017. The renovation costs for 2018 and 2019 have been estimated using renovation and expansion permits granted for commercial and office buildings. For industrial and warehouse buildings, the realised costs were studied with an inquiry in 2018 and the years 2019 to 2020 were estimated based on data on granted renovation and expansion permits. Correspondingly, the renovation costs of service buildings were studied with an inquiry for 2019 and estimated based on granted renovation and expansion permits for 2020.
