Labour Force Survey's first employer sector data following the new classification have been published on 23 April 2020

A new classification of employer sectors based on the standard Classification of Sectors 2012 was introduced at the beginning of 2020. Employer sector data according to the new classification have been published for the first time in the release of data for March and the first quarter on 23 April 2020. To ensure the quality of classified data, employer sector data for January and February 2020 will be published only now retrospectively.

The data according to the new and old classifications are not fully comparable with each other. For the comparison, employer sector data for the statistical reference year and the comparison year will be published with the new classification in the appendix tables of the monthly and quarterly releases for 2020. Comparison data according to the new classification are published only in the appendix tables of the monthly and quarterly releases.

It should be noted in the use of the Labour Force Survey's employer sector data that after the classification change, enterprises owned by a municipality or joint municipal authority are classified under the private sector. In the old classification, enterprises owned by a municipality or joint municipal authority were classified in the local government sector.
